

Clap your name

Title	Clap your name/pattern in sounds and movements
Category	Patterns
Goal	Improve rhythm awareness and recognition;
Age	1-12 grade
Activities & Instructions	<p>The class stands in a circle. The teacher explains the game of clapping names. Everyone spells his name so that every time he or she spells a vowel he or she taps with his feet and when spells a consonant he or she claps his hands. The spelling should be done with a permanent rhythm. Now everyone presents himself with this game while others are repeating the spelling.</p> <p>Next turn: the class is divided into pairs. Now both partners are spelling their own names at the same time with the same pace.</p> <p>They answer the question: after how many spelled letters, the first letters of their names will be spelled at the same time again.</p>
